

Automatic Mutual Recognition Update

Dear Surveyor,

Following on from our previous communications the NSW Government has made the decision to postpone the implementation of Automatic Mutual Recognition (AMR) in NSW for 6 months.

This means that licenced surveyors from other jurisdictions wishing to work in NSW as a Registered Land Surveyor will continue to do so under Mutual Recognition. If NSW is your home state (i.e. you live in NSW and your operational office is based in NSW) and you are a Registered Land Surveyor in NSW you may work under AMR in those jurisdictions that have commenced AMR, this includes Victoria and ACT (from the 1st of July 2022).

Dual registration will continue to be made available for Registered Land Surveyors in which ACT is their home state*

The BOSSI system has maintained all NSW registrations as prior to the original announcement and renewals will be distributed to all NSW Surveyors as per previous years. The updated NSW Fee schedule is available

**If you choose to maintain dual registration, you will need to follow the same process as previous years and pay the fee to BOSSI. You will also need to fill out a Continuation Notice and email it to the Registrar of Surveyors at registrar.surveyors@act.gov.au. The Continuation Notice form can be found via <https://www.legislation.act.gov.au/View/af/2015-64/current/PDF/2015-64.PDF>. The current due dates for Continuation Notice will still apply, you will need to submit the Continuation Notice before 1 September 2022. NSW and ACT will continue the current Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) agreement in regards to CPD for the forthcoming CPD year (2022-2023). There will be ongoing discussions about how to manage CPD once AMR is fully implemented in NSW*
