



Mining Examination Exemption Request Form

Candidates must ensure that the project presented to the Board meets the requirements set for that project in the examination determination before attempting the examination. If a candidate is unsure about their project, they should seek advice from their mentoring surveyor. Candidates must have any project that does not strictly meet the requirements outlined in the determination pre-approved by the Board. If an exemption application is approved the candidate must bring a copy of this application and approval to the examination to be presented to the examiners.

The approved project/s must comply with the requirements of the examination determination and must have been undertaken by the candidate under the mentorship of a mentoring surveyor in the two years immediately preceding the date of the exam. If the project is outside the prescribed time frame, the candidate may apply to BOSSI to have this requirement waived. BOSSI may at its absolute discretion accept or reject an application and apply conditions to any acceptance.

This form is for minor deviations from the determination requirements only. Relevant supporting information must be provided with your exemption request. E.g. planning report, draft plan, CRE report, search if applicable.
